President's Message

Pro Codes Act: is bipartisan legislation, introduced in the House as H.R. 4072 in June 2025, that aims to clarify that <u>Standards Development Organizations (SDOs)</u> can retain their <u>copyright protection</u> on safety codes and standards even after those codes are incorporated into law. The goal is to allow non-profit SDOs to self-fund the creation and updating of these critical codes while also ensuring free and transparent access to them for the public. Critics argue the bill could lead to restricted access to laws and turn them into a private enterprise product, but supporters say it is necessary to protect the development process and public safety.

Ohio Senate Bill 6: Certified Building Departments:

Recently, the Ohio General Assembly adopted changes to laws affecting certified building departments. First, <u>SB 6</u> effective September 30, 2025, permits an owner or owner's authorized representative to request an expedited appeal of an order issued by the building official under the Ohio Building Code to be heard by either the Ohio Board of Building Appeals (OBBA) or certified Local Board of Building Appeals. The OBBA has updated its appeal form to reflect this option. See attached. Questions regarding the OBBA expedited appeal process should be directed to Susan Steer at Susan.Steer@com.ohio.gov.

HB 96:

Next, the latest State biennium budget bill, <u>HB 96</u>, includes amendments authorizing the Board to adopt rules for third-party plans examination and inspections (individuals hired directly by the owner or owner authorized representative) as well as allowing a certified residential building department to be certified to enforce only new construction provisions of the Residential Code of Ohio (RCO) or both new construction and alterations provisions. These amendments are also effective September 30, 2025.

President's Message

Rules for third-party plans examination and inspections

The Board will soon begin drafting rules to allow certified building departments to accept plans examination and inspections reports from third-parties. Notifications will be issued when the draft rules are available for stakeholder input. Until the Board adopts rules for third party plans examination and inspections, requirements for certified personnel to be employed by or under contract with a certified building department to perform inspection and plans examination duties remain unchanged.

Certified residential building department authority change

Existing certified residential building department authority are unaffected by the change permitting departments to define its scope of RCO enforcement. No action is necessary for existing certified residential departments to continue to enforce the RCO for both new construction and alterations. However, if an existing certified department chooses to limit its authority to new construction only, the change requires an application to the Board for certification modification.

You are encouraged to share this information with your department's legal counsel for further guidance and questions.

Fire Marshal's Report

Fire Prevention in Focus

Fire Hazards Associated with Home Oxygen Therapy





Due to underlying medical conditions, some residents use home oxygen therapy as part of their necessary treatment routine. It is important that these residents are aware of fire hazards associated with this therapy, and provide best practices in how to mitigate the risk.

Fire needs oxygen to burn. When more oxygen is available, fires can ignite at lower temperatures, burn hotter, and spread faster than most people realize. When a person is using home oxygen therapy, their clothes and other combustibles around them can become saturated with the excess oxygen. Even when the supply is turned off, these combustibles will remain saturated for several minutes until dissipation can occur. If a heat source is introduced during this time, a fire will ignite rapidly and spread quickly causing burns to the person and rapidly spreading to other areas of the home.

Fire Marshal's Report

The main ignition source for these types of fires are lit cigarettes, e-cigarettes and vaping pens. Home oxygen therapy fires can also be caused by the person getting too close to candles, stoves, grills and other ignition sources while the medical oxygen is present.

The best way to prevent these fires is to never smoke or be around other ignition sources while on, or directly after, home oxygen therapy. In addition, there is a device that can be installed on the oxygen tubing called a thermal fuse. A thermal fuse is a safety device designed to stop the spread of fire, if the tubing ignites, by melting closed at a preset temperature cutting off the oxygen supply in the tubing. Some local fire departments are able to obtain the thermal fuses from the State Fire Marshal's Office and then install them for the resident free of charge.
